Mazur takes the scenic route to complex numbers, via a deep exploration of their history and a brief tour of the science of the imagination. A readable book.

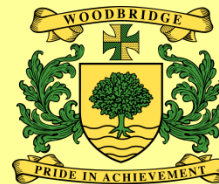
A Very Short Introduction to Mathematics by *Timothy Gowers*
