



Sixth Form - The Dress Code

All sixth form students must wear smart dress 5 days a week. Below are details of the current dress code.

Lanyards and ID Cards must be worn at ALL times by ALL students

BOYS

Smart (tailored) Suit – any colour
Smart Shirt & Tie - any colour
Smart shoes - any colour

OR

Smart Trousers – any colour
Smart shirt & tie (any colour)
Smart shoes – any colour
Jumpers can only be worn over a shirt and tie – not on their own

GIRLS

Smart (tailored) Suit – can be Dress, skirt or trousers (with jacket)
Smart shirt/blouse (any colour)
Smart sensible shoes / boots
Dresses or skirts must be of appropriate length
Shoulders and midriffs must be covered
No leggings are to be worn at any time

OR

Smart tailored trousers – any colour
Smart skirt – any colour
Smart shirt / blouse – any colour
Dresses or skirts must be of appropriate length
Shoulders and midriffs must be covered

OUTER GARMENTS not in keeping with the dresscode, e.g. sports coats must be removed inside school buildings.

MOBILE PHONES, EARPHONES AND HEADPHONES

Use of these items is only permitted in the 6th Form area and should not be used anywhere else in school, other than in lessons with the express permission of the teacher i.e. for learning purposes

BTEC Sport students

It is a requirement for students on this course to wear sportswear approved and ordered by the PE department. This consists of the following:

Polo shirt (Woodbridge High School logo)
Black shorts (Woodbridge High School logo)
Black tracksuit bottoms / leggings (Woodbridge High School logo)
Fleece / Track suit jacket – optional (Woodbridge High School logo)

If students choose not to wear the above then they must follow the standard sixth form dress code.

Headscarves

A dark, plain, unpatterned, headscarf (no tassels, logos, fringes or brightly coloured clips) is acceptable, but the face must not be obscured in any way. This is for reasons of school security, in order to foster a sense of social

cohesion and in order to discharge essential communication skills in education. In our view non-verbal communication, including facial expression is a vital part of a young person's education if they are to take full economic and social role in 21st century British society.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OF CLOTHING / FOOTWEAR:

- Jeans
- Trainers / pumps / canvas footwear / flip flops etc i.e. not smart shoes
- Clubbing Clothes of any description
- Shorts of any description
- Tracksuits other than BTEC Sports students wearing the school tracksuit (see above)
- Hoodies
- Leggings

Students not adhering to this dress code will not be allowed on site, or will be sent home
