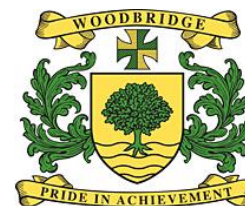

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# Which Course?

Course	Length	Information	Entry Req.
<b>Sixth Form Foundation Course</b>	1 year	Business <u>or</u> Health & Social Care at Level 2, with Maths, English and supervised study. Can lead to VTQ Courses.	25 points
<b>VTQ Courses</b>	2 years	Choose a combination of VTQ courses. Assessed by coursework and exams. Equivalent to three A Levels.	45 points
<b>Three A Levels</b>	2 years	Mostly assessed by exams in Y13. Consider studying an Extended Project or Maths Studies alongside.	50 points
<b>Combination of A Levels and VTQs</b>	2 years	A wide range of subjects to choose from. Equivalent to three A levels.	50 points
<b>Four A Levels</b>	2 years	Speak to the 6 <sup>th</sup> form team if interested.

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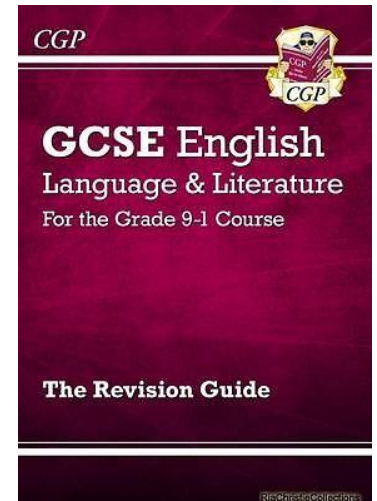
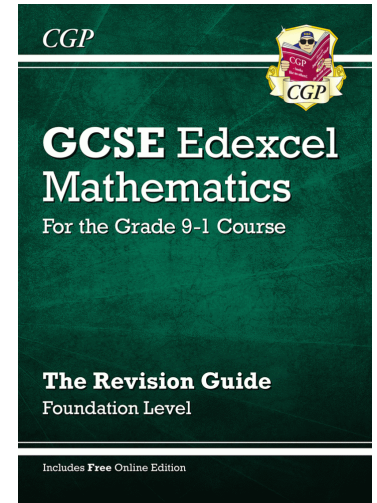
# Choices

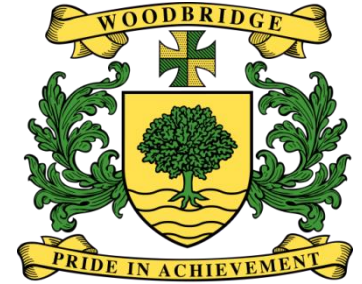
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
