Students should come in for their first test before they start school. They will then have a second test in school 3-5 days later.

Testing is not compulsory, but is strongly advised. The tables below show when students should attend for onsite testing. The time and date are different for each tutor group.

Attending for the First Test

Students should wear a mask when they come for their first test and enter through Wynndale Gate. They do not need to wear uniform for their first test.

If parents have not given consent or do not wish their child to be tested, then they do not need to come in for the first test. They should stay at home on the testing day and start school with the rest of their year group.

Parents may attend the first test with new year 7 students if they are worried.

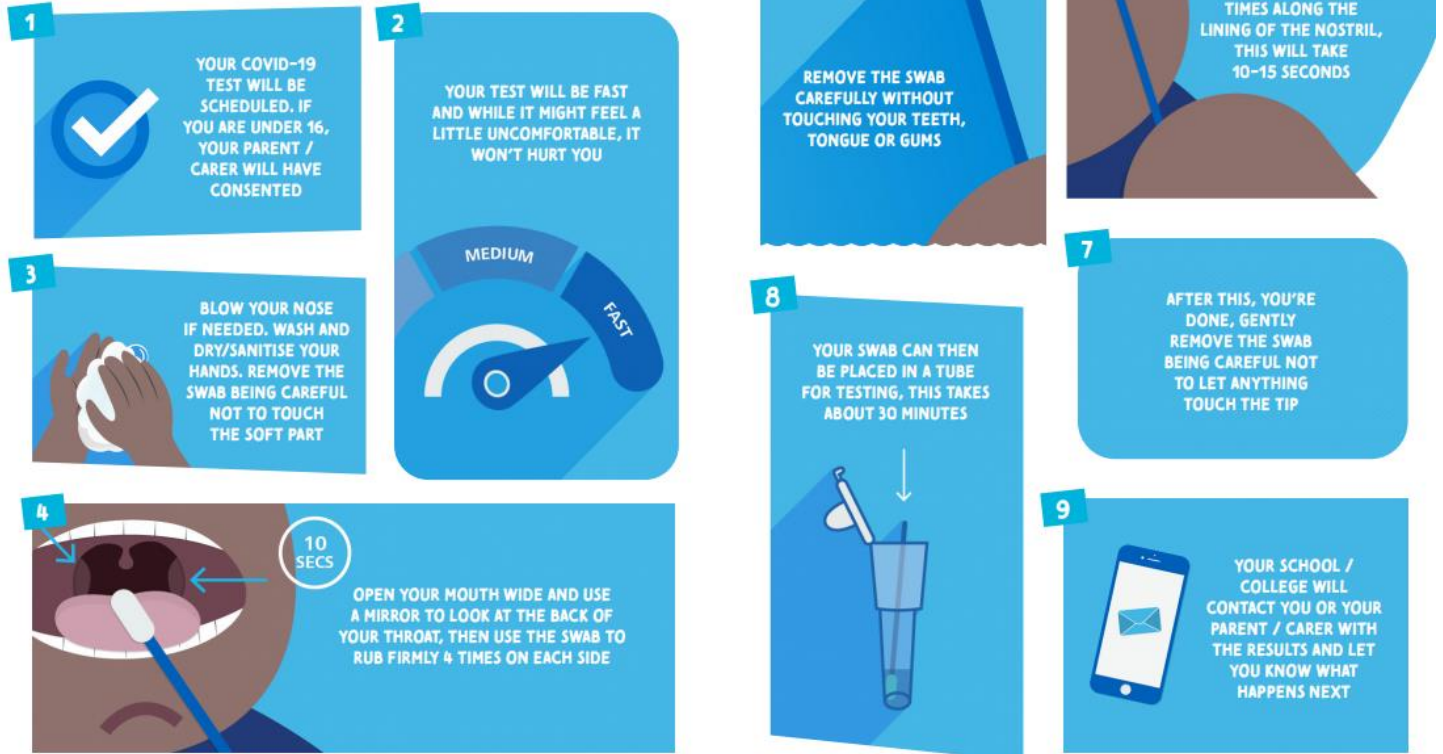
Testing Logistics

When students come for testing, they swab themselves under instruction from a trained member of staff or trained volunteer. The first tests will involve a throat and nose swab, and the second will involve nose swabs only.

Students must conduct the swabbing themselves but will be told what to do by staff. No one else will be able to do the swabbing for them. After the swabbing, the test is then processed by a trained testing operative.

Test Results

After their first test, students should leave the school site through the Wynndale Gate and return straight home. Test results take about 30 minutes to come through and can then take up a further 1-2 hours to be texted and emailed to you by the NHS.

After their second test, students will return to their lesson.

If the test result is positive, we will call the parent. Parents will then need to book a confirmatory PCR test for their child. If it is negative, parents will receive the information by text message and email later the same day.

Consent for Testing

Parents should have received an email from the school which asks them to confirm the consent (or not) that we hold for onsite testing for Covid-19. If parents would like to change their consent, then they should complete the form that was emailed to them. New Year 7 parents must complete the form before onsite testing can take place.

Testing cannot take place without parental consent. If a child does not have consent for testing, they should not attend on the testing day but instead return to school with their year group as normal.
