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English Baccalaureate (Ebacc)

Achieved by students who gain GCSE grade 5 or better in:

- English Language or English Literature
- Mathematics
- Two Sciences
- Language
- History or Geography

- Graded 9-1

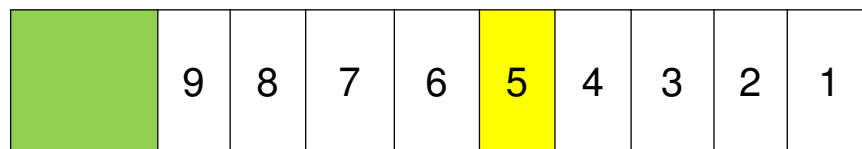
