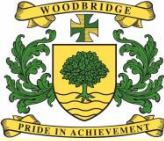


TRANSITION TO WOODBRIDGE

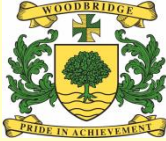

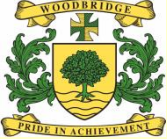


FINDING OUT MORE

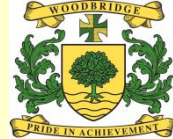
- **School Tours:**

HOW WILL THE ADMISSIONS SYSTEM WORK?

- Online application system called 'eAdmissions'. Information pack available: www.redbridge.gov.uk
- Apply through the LA where you live
- Parents can rank up to 6 schools in order of preference
- Recommended to name catchment area school within rankings
- Offer made for school ranked highest provided that admissions criteria are met and there are spaces



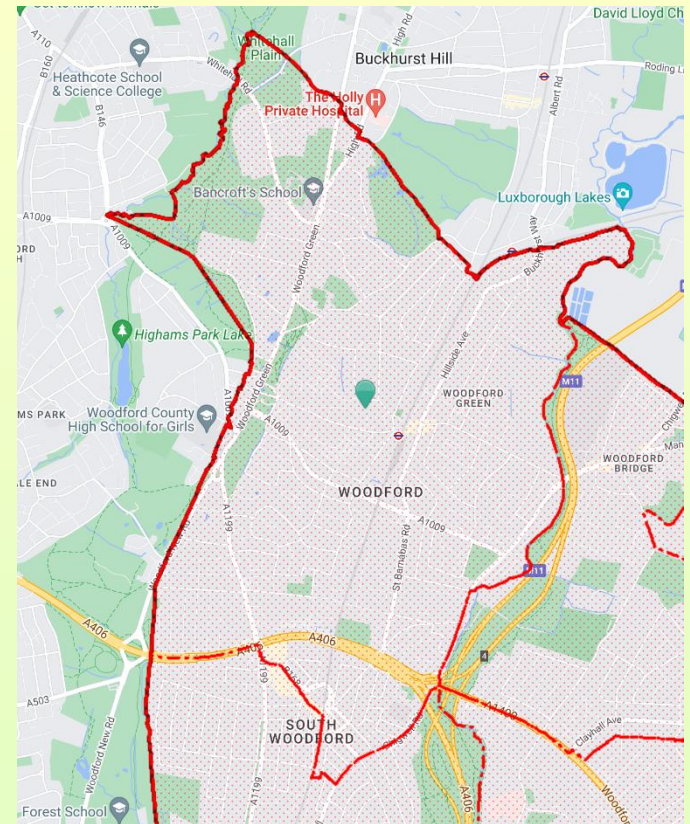
