

- Apply through the LA where you live
- Parents can rank up to 6 schools in order of preference
- Recommended to name catchment area school within rankings
- Offer made for school ranked highest provided that admissions criteria are met and there are spaces






WHAT ARE THE ADMISSIONS CRITERIA?

- 2. Looked-After Children
- 3. Children of Staff
- 4. Catchment Siblings (Y7-10)
- 5. Children Living in Catchment
- 6. Non-Catchment Siblings (Y7-10)
- 7. Children Living out of Catchment

 - deadline for online applications to your own Local Authority Admissions Department
- 2nd March 2026:
 - Results available online and offer letter sent to parents from Local Authority giving outcome of all preferences
- March to July 2026:
 - Allocations continue and appeals heard
