



Sixth Form - The Dress Code

Sixth Form students at Woodbridge High School are expected to wear smart, professional dress 5 days a week, to reflect the desired attitude towards their studies. We believe that Sixth Form students should be seen as role models to younger students and this extends to their appearance. 'Smart' is to be judged by the school's staff and is not negotiable. Below are details of the current dress code, which is applicable for entrance to the school site, regardless of duration (i.e. applicable whether they have one lesson on a particular day or several).

Lanyards and ID Cards must be worn at ALL times by ALL students. Students may not enter the site without their ID card.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A suit, comprising of any of the items below - Smart shirt or blouse with a collar - Smart plain, non-patterned jumper (ideally over shirt or blouse) - Blazer - Plain, non-patterned cardigan - Tie, bow-tie or cravat (not compulsory) - Smart trousers (not skin-tight) - Smart skirt, of appropriate, professional length - A dress, of appropriate, professional length - Tights (accompanied by a dress or skirt) - Smart, leather shoes of any colour (plain). Heels must be low. - Leather boots (plain) - Headscarf (not covering the face) - Outdoor coat (not to be worn in lessons) - Small earrings only allowed, eyebrow/nose/other face studs are not allowed. - In snowy conditions, footwear may include snow boots or trainers - Hats, gloves and scarves 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jeans or other denim items (i.e. skirts or jackets) - Footwear deemed not to be smart (trainers, canvas/Converse type shoes, sandals or flip-flops) - Leggings or jeggings - Sportswear - Hoodies, including WHS hoodies - T-shirts, short or long sleeved - Polo shirts - Shorts of any kind - High-heeled shoes or boots - Mini-skirts - Cropped tops - Bandanas and other non-religious headwear - See-through clothing - Tattoos must be covered

Level 3 Sport Students

It is a requirement for students on this course to wear sportswear approved and ordered by the PE department. This consists of the following:

- Polo shirt (Woodbridge High School logo)
- Black shorts (Woodbridge High School logo)
- Black tracksuit bottoms / leggings (Woodbridge High School logo)
- Fleece / Track suit jacket – optional (Woodbridge High School logo)

If students choose not to wear the above then they must follow the standard sixth form dress code.

Additional notes:

- Shoulders and midribs must be covered
- Advice on items not on this list, including new fashion trends, should be sought from either Mr Samuels or Miss Iyengar before wearing
- If students are in breach of this dress code, they should expect sanction and/or for this to be referred, which could include being asked to leave the site, refused entry to the site, or be excluded. Parents do not need to be notified if this happens. The sanction may include being asked to wear lower school uniform instead of leaving the site.
- Outer garments, such as coats, hats, gloves and scarves, must not be worn in lessons.

MOBILE PHONES, EARPHONES AND HEADPHONES

Use of these items is only permitted in the 6th Form area and must not be used anywhere else in school, other than in lessons with the express permission of the teacher i.e. for learning purposes. Such items visible outside of the Sixth Form area risk confiscation. Phone calls must not be made in Private Study Area 1 at any time.

The need to wear items on the 'not allowed' list

There may be occasions when students need to wear items on the 'not allowed' list, for example due to injury or a medical condition. In this case, a parent or guardian must write a note and this must be presented to Mr Samuels or Miss Iyengar for their consideration.
