Aspects of the RSHE curriculum are incorporated into the Sixth Form Character Programme for students in Years 12 and 13.

Overview

The Sixth Form Character Programme will be delivered through various pastoral sessions:

- Daily registration sessions with form tutors
 - o Mondays Study Skills
 - o Tuesdays Assembly
 - o Wednesdays Health, Wellbeing and relationships
 - o Thursdays Culture, citizenship and wider knowledge
 - o Fridays Post-18 Pathways: University, Apprenticeships and Careers
- Fortnightly form period study skills, post-18 pathways and living in the wider world
- · Fortnightly enrichment sessions
- Termly 'drop down' days with external providers
