You asked we listened!!

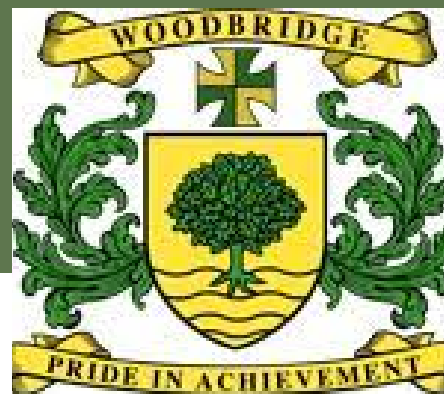
In the 2021/22 Student Voice extra curricular survey, many of you said that you don't engage with extra curricular clubs because there is no incentive!

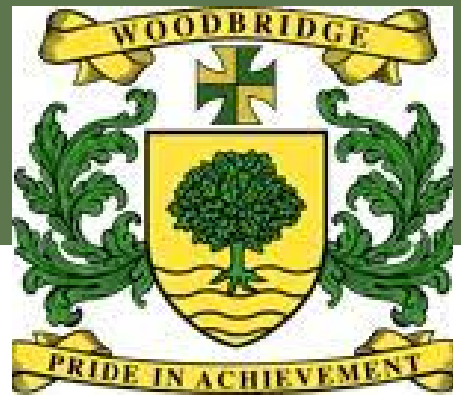

- The Band's Visit

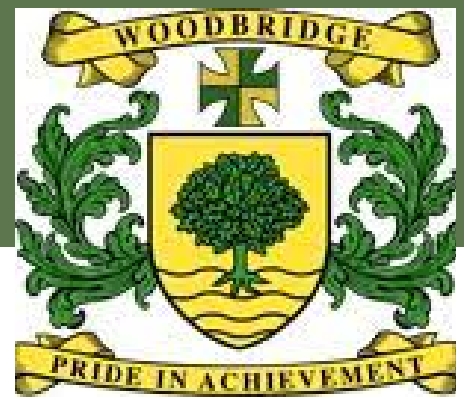
