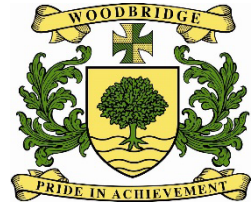

Excellent Results for Woodbridge High School Students at A Level

Year 13 students at Woodbridge High School have been collecting their A Level and Level 3 vocational and technical (VTQ) results today.

The school is once again very pleased to report many excellent achievements by students this year.

Oliver Foot said "I'm really happy with what I've achieved. I got an A in Biology, but in the mocks, I got a C. So if you get knocked down, just get back up."

Aadam Shah was delighted and said "I didn't expect to get three A*s, I was hoping for three A's. I'm doing a gap year and then off to study Accountancy and Finance."

Milli Durbarry, on getting three A's remarked, "The school was very supportive. I was struggling but the teachers helped me to get the grades that I did. They provide a lot of support outside of normal school time. I will be going to study Politics and International Relations at Warwick."

At Woodbridge this year, 23% of all A Levels were graded A*-A and 58% were graded A*-B. In vocational courses, 45% of students achieved a Distinction or Distinction*. These results represent another significant achievement for the school.

Steven Hogan, Headteacher at Woodbridge High School, said: "I am so pleased with the results that our students have achieved in this year's A Level and VTQ exams. It has been a pleasure to see the smiles on their faces as they have opened their results envelopes today."
