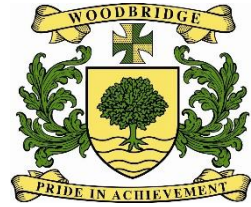

Woodbridge Headteacher Celebrates “Superb” GCSE Results

Woodbridge High School is celebrating some excellent GCSE and Cambridge National results for students in year 11 today. Students were at the school in Woodford Green this morning to collect their results envelopes and to enrol for the school’s Sixth Form.

A large number of students achieved outstanding outcomes in their exams, including some of the highest achievers who achieved straight grades 8 and 9. The school saw 26pc of all GCSEs graded at 7 or better. As well as this, 75pc of all students achieved grade 4 or better in both English and Maths.

Archie Berg achieved three 9s, four 8s and a 7 will be taking up a place in the Sixth Form at Woodbridge in September. Archie said “I was really hoping for these results but didn’t expect it! I’m shocked. I will be studying Economics, English Language and Politics at Woodbridge.”

Ben Higgins will be studying A Levels at Woodbridge in September. Ben was delighted with his results, achieving six 9s, three 8s and one 7. He said, “I’m ecstatic to get the results I did. The school really supported me and I’d like to thank the teachers and everyone who helped me. I will be staying Woodbridge to study Maths, Further Maths, Economics and Physics”.

Lucie Sattaur-Lennon who achieved five 9s, one 8 and three 9s said “I feel really happy as I was really stressed. I was locked in my room revising, to see the results today is really nice because you know all the hard work has paid off”

The school has said that the majority of students will be continuing at Woodbridge as they will join its Sixth Form in September, with enrolment taking place today and tomorrow. Woodbridge offers one of the widest ranges of A Level and vocational courses available locally. There may be some places left for students from other schools for some courses, and staff will be on hand at the school to advise.

Steven Hogan, Headteacher at Woodbridge High School, said: “Our year 11 students have achieved some superb results this year, and I am a very proud Headteacher. Once again, our students have aimed for excellence and achieved it.

I am particularly pleased about the fact that our highest attainers have achieved strings of grades 8 and 9, as the school continues to go from strength to strength in terms of academic outcomes across all subjects.

Having said that, every one of our students is an individual, and GCSE exam grades act like a passport to the next stage in their lives. I am so pleased that so many now have the opportunities that they deserve after their hard work.

I often tell Woodbridge students that they are the best kids I know, and it was a privilege to see their excited faces as they collected their results this morning and shared their triumphs with their friends. They are total superstars.”
