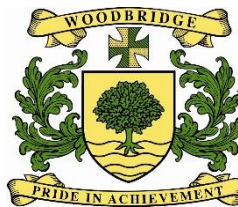

Woodbridge Headteacher Celebrates GCSE Results

Woodbridge High School is celebrating some excellent GCSE and Cambridge National results for students in year 11 today. Students were at the school in Woodford Green this morning to collect their results envelopes and to enrol for the school's Sixth Form.

A large number of students achieved outstanding outcomes in their exams, including some of the highest achievers who achieved straight grades 8 and 9. A third of all exams taken this year were graded at 7 or better, making these the school's best ever GCSE results.

Sophie Flegg was delighted with her achievements and praised the support she received from staff, "I'm so happy with my results. Teachers have been supportive, so it was lovely to see some of my teachers and share my results with them. I will be coming to Woodbridge to study Psychology, Business and Maths."

There was a double celebration for twins Adam Khanifis and Daa Khanifis, who were collecting their results on their birthday. Daa said: "It's our birthday today and getting our results has made it extra special. We did much better than we thought we would and feel really happy. We are off to celebrate now!"

Abdalla Elgerbi was equally thrilled with his results and grateful for the encouragement he received from teachers throughout his studies, "I'm ecstatic with my results. My teachers really helped me to get my grades up and I'm so thankful. I'm really happy that I will be studying Politics, Sociology and Economics at Woodbridge."

Among the highest achievers was Tsvyatko Mangov, who secured six grade 9s, two grade 8s, two grade 7s and a Distinction Star in Extended Maths. "I am so, so happy with my results. I first saw my 9 in Chemistry and was really surprised. School has been great and really helped me a lot."

The majority of students will be continuing at Woodbridge as they will join its Sixth Form in September, with enrolment taking place today and tomorrow. Woodbridge offers one of the widest ranges of A Level and vocational courses available locally. There may be some places left for students from other schools for some courses, and staff will be on hand at the school to advise.

Steven Hogan, Headteacher at Woodbridge High School, said: "Our year 11 students have achieved our best ever results this year. They have aimed for excellence and achieved it."

It is particularly great to see that many students have achieved strings of grades 8 and 9, have their pick of Sixth Form places, but will be returning to Woodbridge for their studies. Our congratulations go to all our students for their incredible hard work.

I often tell Woodbridge students that they are the best kids I know, and it was a privilege to see their excited faces as they collected their results this morning and shared their triumphs with their friends. They are total superstars."
